### **Sewer Construction Temporary Traffic Pattern Change**

Chatham – On Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting, sewer construction in the intersection of Route 28 and Old Queen Anne Road will result in a temporary change in the ongoing Route 28 detour.

From 7 am to approximately 12 pm (noon) on Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup> the section of Old Queen Anne Road between Stepping Stones Road and Route 28 will be closed to thru traffic. Local traffic will be allowed to access homes in the area.

Traffic coming into Chatham via Old Queen Anne Road will be detoured onto Stepping Stones Road then onto Heritage Lane to Route 28. Traffic heading out of Chatham via Old Queen Anne Road from Route 28 should use Heritage Lane to Stepping Stones to Old Queen Anne Road or follow Route 28 to George Ryder Road, Sam Ryder Road, or Route 137 to Old Queen Anne Road.

Route 28 will be open to all traffic during the intersection work. During the intersection work Route 28 at the intersection with Old Queen Anne Road will be restricted to one lane of alternating traffic.

Following completion of the Old Queen Anne intersection work at approximately 12 pm (noon) the affected section of Old Queen Anne Road will re-open to all traffic and the detour of Route 28 thru traffic between George Ryder Road and Old Queen Anne Road will resume.

There will be extensive signage and Police Detail Officers to assist traffic in reaching their destinations. Access to all residences and businesses in the affected area will be maintained throughout the construction.
