Sewer Construction Traffic Pattern Changes

Chatham – Starting Monday April 25th, sewer construction is scheduled to take place on Route 28 between Barn Hill Road and Old Queen Anne Road with this stretch of Route 28 closed to thru traffic. A detour for thru traffic will be in-place utilizing George Ryder Road to Old Queen Anne Road back to Route 28. This detour is expected to be in-place until May 26th. Local traffic will be allowed along Route 28 from either Barn Hill Road or Old Queen Anne Road depending on the final destination.

Also starting Monday April 25th and continuing through approximately May 6th, final trench paving for the sewer project is scheduled to take place on Route 28 between Sam Ryder Road and Beacon Hill with this stretch of Route 28 closed to thru traffic. A detour for thru traffic will be in-place utilizing Route 137 to Middle Road to Sam Ryder Road to back to Route 28. Local traffic will be allowed along Route 28 from either Route 137 or Sam Ryder Road depending on the final destination.

The sewer construction will be during the hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. with possible extension to 7 p.m. as allowed by the MassDOT permit. Access will be fully available during the evening (after 7 p.m.) and overnight hours.

There will be extensive signage and Police Detail Officers to assist traffic.
